Stories for History: Polyphony of Psychiatry.

This project from evolved an acknowledgement, shared by practitioners and researchers working in the field of mental health: transmission of professional skills fails to account the oral narrative and the historical context of the psychiatry in the French speaking part of Switzerland. This aims make to students. professionals and the general public aware of the complexity of psychiatry, through a documentary support with "filmed portraits", which reflect the variety of actors in the psychiatrie field nurses, architects, psychiatrists, occupational therapists, patients, pharmacists, neuroscientists, historians, etc.).

This project seeks:

(a) to value the importance of oral transmission in the psychiatrie field (b) to show the various issues of practicing psychiatry, at an historical level, in therapeutic knowledge, in staries and in mental health policies.

We work with two partners, IUHMSP (Institute of History of Medicine) and Facteur (i) Interfaculty Research Group of the University of Lausanne.
